Arthur and Lois Manning reside in Dubuque Iowa along with their four children Steven, Michael, Rebekah, and Elizabeth.

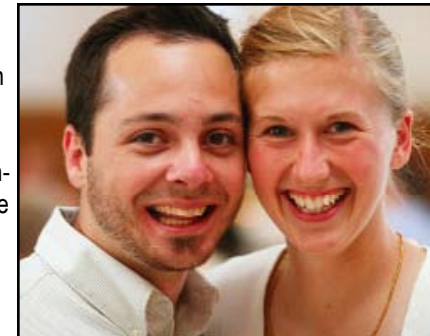
Arthur has been teaching in the Computer Information Systems department at Emmaus Bible College since 2001.
