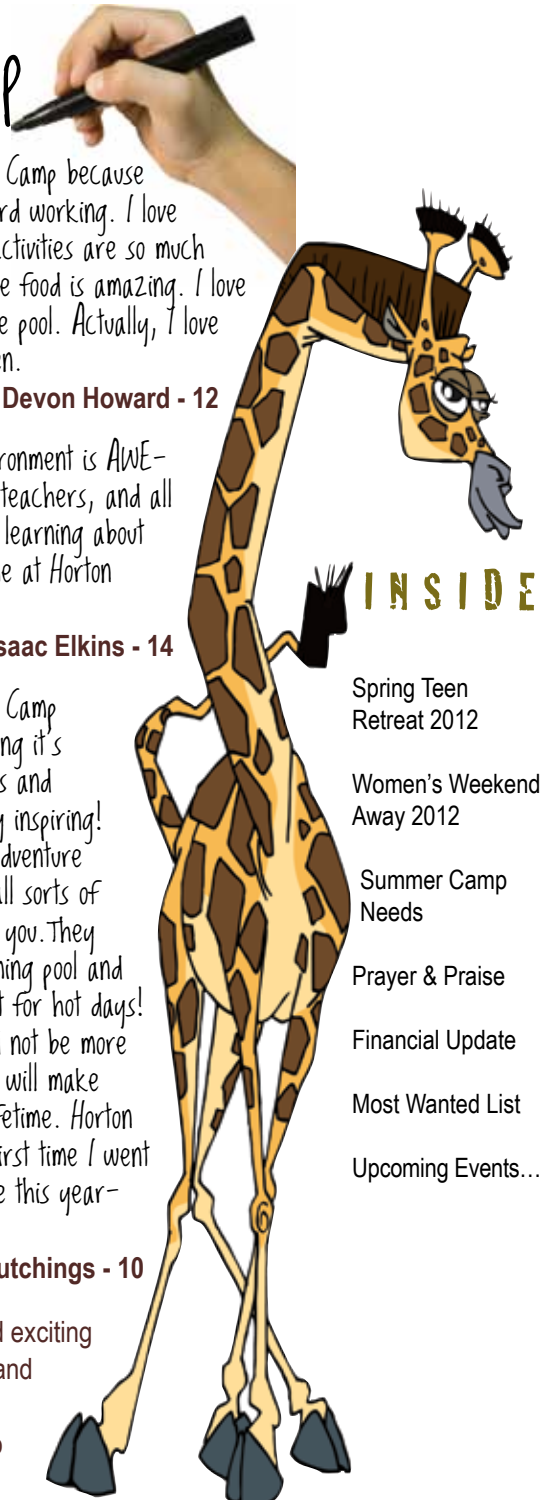
I love camp because the environment is AWESOME! From the counselors, teachers, and all the activities, it's really cool learning about Jesus and having a great time at Horton Haven!
